Day trip, 21 June 2023

Bernardin – Hrastovlje - Štanjel – wine tasting - Bernardin

14:00 - Departure from the seaside town of Portorož.

14:45 – A visit to **Hrastovlje**, best known for its Holy Trinity Church which contains a late medieval Danse Macabre frescoes. It is said to be one of the best preserved monuments of its kind in Slovenia.

15:45 - Departure to the Karst region of Slovenia and the charming town of **Štanjel**.

16:45 – Arrival to Štanjel. It first enchants visitors with its unique panorama. Once you approach the mighty castle, take a walk along narrow stone alleys and enter the Ferrari Garden, it is unforgettable.

18:00 – Departure from Štanjel.

18:15 - Karst region offers a great diversity of local delights that are based on the regional and seasonal ingredients. Thanks to its harsh weather conditions, it boasts some of the best wines and prosciutto. We will head to local wine producer, winery or a tourist farm, for a **wine tasting accompanied by snack**.

19:30 – Departure towards the hotel.

20:30 - Arrival.

Minor adjustments to the schedule are possible.

Price:
